

# Health & Safety Law Reform

**In the wake of the Pike River Mine tragedy, the NZ Government is implementing major reforms to New Zealand's health and safety law.**

Individuals in governance and management roles in charitable entities need to be aware of the implications and impact these changes will have on managing health and safety in the not-for-profit sector and the risk of personal liability.
