

Health & Safety Law Reform Briefing for not-for-profit organisations

In the wake of the Pike River Mine tragedy, the NZ Government is implementing major reforms to New Zealand's health and safety law.

Individuals in governance and management roles in charitable entities need to be aware of the implications and impact these changes will have on managing health and safety in the not-for-profit sector and the risk of personal liability.

- The development of the PCBU & its impact on not-for-profit organisations
- New "due diligence" duty for those in governance and management roles
- The substantial increase in penalties and consequences for breaching particular duties
